










For example IP 67 would be: Totally protected against ingress of dust & protected against the effects of immersion between 15cm and 1m.

First Numeral

Protection against ingress of solid foreign objects.

Second Numeral

Protection against harmful ingress of water

1	Full penetration of 50mm diameter sphere not allowed and shall have adequate clearance from hazardous parts. Contact with hazardous parts not permitted.		1	Protected against vertically falling drops of water. Limited ingress permitted.	
2	Full penetration of 12.5mm diameter sphere not allowed. The jointed finger shall have adequate clearance from hazardous parts.		2	Protected against vertically falling drops of water with enclosure tilted 15° from the vertical. Limited ingress permitted.	
3	The access probe of 2.5mm diameter shall not penetrate.		3	Protected against sprays to 60° from the vertical - limited ingress permitted.	
4	The access probe of 1.0mm diameter shall not penetrate.		4	Protected against water splashed from all directions - limited ingress permitted.	
5	Limited ingress of dust permitted (no harmful deposit).		5	Protected against low-pressure jets of water from all directions - limited ingress permitted.	
6	Totally protected against ingress of dust.		6	Protected against strong jets of water.	
			7	Protected against the effects of immersion between 15cm and 1m.	
			8	Protected against longer periods of immersion under pressure.
